Youth Impacted

In line with Tanari's aim to empower youth for life, we have seen different teens and youth impacted through our creative and transformative programs, in which several institutions are involved as they engage the next generation. Our self – giving friends, volunteers, facilitators and passionate, committed staff have helped us to fulfill our mission.

Since the month of July, Tanari had an opportunity to impact different youths of different ages and make a difference in their lives. From schools to churches to youth centers, Tanari was actively involved.

CPR Program

CPR was conducted in different institutions including; Thika Road Christian school, ICC West Church, Asante Africa, St Mary's Sport's view, Karuri Primary, PCEA Gateway St Patrick's Isinya and ICC Kitengela. The young men and women in this institution got to interact with the activities and information that is conveyed through the CPR program. As an institution we felt that the aim of CPR which is to shape attitudes and increase knowledge about one of the most difficult issues in adolescent life; sexuality, was achieved.

Ropes

The ROPES programs, activities and parent's sessions have been running in different institutions such as ACK St. Paul's, AIC Langata, Life Spring Syokimau, Loisswell Academy, PCEA Ruai, Karen Community Church, Ridgeways Baptist and Jabali Elementary School. We saw the progression in the life's of the teenagers as they continued to learn and the parent's got to have a better understanding of what goes on in the lives of their adolescents.

Mental Health

Tanari has engaged in training youth in issues of Mental Health and Drugs and Substance abuse. Different students in various institutions have benefitted including St Georges Girls High School, Thika Road Christian School, Makadara Children Centre and KAG Githongocho. This new introduction to Tanari's program has helped us to think about the challenges the youths are facing and how we can reach out to them.

Through the above programs we experienced positive youth development taking place and we are glad to be a part of it.



New Premises



31st March 2019 will remain to be a significant date in the history of Tanari Trust. This was the day Tanari relocated from Nairobi Baptist Church Court unit 4 on Green Lane off Ngong Road to the new premises in Ngumo, Highview Phase 2 House Number 131. It has been eight months since we moved and are settled.

Equipped to Empower

At Tanari one of the ways through which we desire to impact the youth is by equipping those who are closely in touch with them such as their parents, teachers, pastors and mentors to empower the young men and women to become God fearing and responsible adults.

CPR Trainings

The CPR trainings on 10th – 12th July and 11th -13th September saw teachers, youth ministers, social workers and different sets of people who are passionate about youth development trained to run the program in their different settings. The aim is to understand sex as God's idea and we felt that this was achieved.

ROPES Trainings

We facilitated different ROPES trainings in different parts of the country. We had our annual July and September trainings which happened on 21st -27th July and 22nd -28th September respectively.

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We facilitated trainings for different institutions such as GCI church, Kijabe Children's Education Fund and Compassion Centre Baringo Cluster. We saw the different groups equipped to understand the Rites of Passage from a Christian Perspective so as to build the community for these young people in the church.

We believe the ministers that have been trained to run our programs are well equipped and can deliver the message effectively.



Training of Counselors

On 6th and 7th July the peer counselors at St Georges were equipped with counseling skills to handle issues that are presented to them by their peers. Through this training they got to acquire emotional intelligence skills as they learnt about mental health, anger management, management of stress, managing emotions, empathy and rapport skills, emotional maturity, self-care and healthy coping mechanisms.



Team Building

Parting Shot

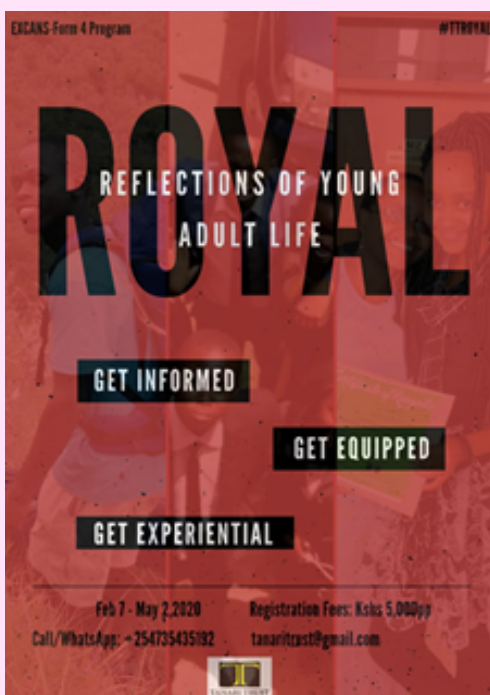

Hoping we all are excited for the ROPES camps ahead of us.

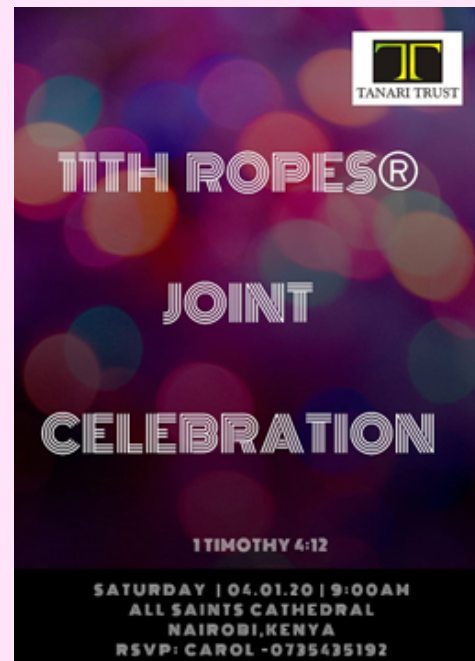
